Charity is a young girl whose father was a soldier and was killed during war. Her mother had many children and married another man who did not want Charity. Her mother was forced to bring her to Home of Hope so that she could provide for her other children. Charity is now able to roll and smile, things she was not doing before coming to Home of Hope, but she still requires 24 hour care, including changing, bathing and feeding. Charity receives regular occupational therapy sessions at Home of Hope, which are currently focused on head control and trunk extension so that eventually she can learn to sit.

Sponsorship for Charity ensures she receives daily meals, clothing, occupational therapy sessions, nursing care when needed and helps provide for the staff that cares for her 24 hours a day. The cost is \$45 per month payable via Paypal, Venmo or check. Sponsorship includes updates on Charity throughout the year and following Our Hope's annual trip to Uganda.
